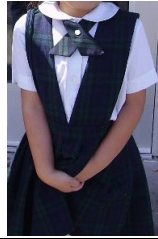


Girl's Full or Formal Dress Options (Every Monday)

Top
Girls must wear either a long or short sleeved white Peter pan collar blouse with a crossover blackwatch plaid tie. The blouse must be tucked into the bottoms worn that day.



Bottom

Girls have the choice of blackwatch plaid, skirt, skort, jumper, or navy skirt or skort. These items must be approved styles and purchased from an approved uniform vendor.



Girls can also wear navy pants or shorts on full dress day. They must be of twill material and dress pants style. (No skinny style of pants are allowed. If the pants or shorts have belt keepers or loops, a dark solid colored belt must be worn. No external sewed pockets (i.e. cargo pants or jean style pants). Pants must be ankle length. Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.



In addition to the above items a navy cardigan or vest is encouraged. **The cardigan and vest must be purchased from an approved vendor with the Timpanogos Academy logo.**



Girl's Regular Dress Options (Tuesday through Friday)

In addition to the full or formal dress options the following may be worn.

Top

Polo and logo must be purchased together from an approved vendor. They can be navy blue, hunter green, or white in a long or short sleeved. A sweatshirt and logo may also be purchased together from an approved vendor.



Optional Bottoms

Khaki colored skirts and skorts must be the approved style and purchased from an approved vendor.



Khaki colored shorts and pants may be purchased from a store of your choice but must be twill material and dress pants style. (No skinny style of pants are allowed. If the pants or shorts have belt keepers or loops, a dark solid colored belt must be worn. No external sewed pockets (i.e. cargo pants or jean style pants). Pants must be ankle length. Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.



Turtlenecks must be white, navy or hunter green. They need to be a solid color and have no pattern/texturing. No mock turtlenecks or decorative collars. Stitching must match the color of the rest of the shirt. Turtlenecks and long sleeve shirts must not be worn underneath polos or oxford shirts.

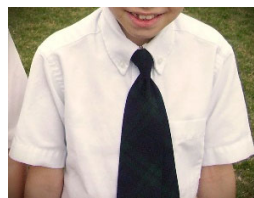
Bike shorts may be worn under skirts or jumpers. They must be white, black, navy or hunter green. They must be shorter than the length of the skirt or jumper.

Leggings may be worn under skirts or jumpers. They must be ankle length and solid in color of white, black, navy or hunter green.

Boy's Full or Formal Dress Options (Every Monday)

Top

Boys must wear a white oxford button down dress shirt with an approved tie. (The collar buttons down over the tie). It can be long or short sleeved.



Bottom

Navy pants or shorts navy pants or shorts on full dress day. They must be of twill material and dress pants style. (No skinny style of pants are allowed. If the pants or shorts have belt keepers or loops, a dark solid colored belt must be worn. No external sewed pockets (i.e. cargo pants or jean style pants). Pants must be ankle length. Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.



In addition to the above items a navy cardigan or vest is encouraged. **The cardigan and vest must be purchased from an approved vendor with the Timpanogos Academy logo.**



For full or formal dress day, the oxford shirt should be buttoned to the top and the buttons on the collar should button the tie in as shown above. For those who do not know, oxford is a type of material.

Boy's Regular Dress Options (Tuesday through Friday)

In addition to the full or formal dress options the following may be worn.

Top

Polo and logo must be purchased together from an approved vendor. They can be navy blue, hunter green, or white in a long or short sleeved. A sweatshirt and logo may also be purchased together from an approved vendor.



Bottom

Khaki colored shorts and pants may be purchased from a store of your choice but must be twill material and dress pants style. (No skinny style of pants are allowed. If the pants or shorts have belt keepers or loops, a dark solid colored belt must be worn. No external sewed pockets (i.e. cargo pants or jean style pants). Pants must be ankle length. Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.



Additional Information: Tights or socks must be worn. Solid in color. Black, white, navy or hunter green. No-show and footie style socks are not acceptable. Bike shorts may be worn under skirts or jumpers. They must be white, black, navy or hunter green. They must be shorter than the length of the skirt or jumper. Ankle length leggings may be worn under skirts or jumpers. They must be solid in color of white, black, navy or hunter green. Shoes or boots are required at all times. Shoes or boots with blinking lights, noisemakers, wheels, heels or soles higher than 2 inches are prohibited at all times including free dress days. All shoes must be closed toe and closed heel.

Spirit Shirts are allowed only on designated Spirit Shirt Day or Free Dress Day.

Logo: The Timpanogos Academy logo is copyrighted and only our APPROVED vendors have permission to use the logo. Please do not attempt to take uniform items to businesses and ask them to print/embroider our logo on them. Also, please do not attempt to print/embroider the logo yourself. This is a violation of copyright law. And will be dealt with accordingly.

If **outerwear** is worn inside the classroom it must be an item that is purchased from an approved vendor. Logoed sweatshirts, hoodies (no hoods up), fleece jackets, fleece vests are the items permitted but not on formal dress day.

Hats are not allowed to be worn in the school at any time including free dress day.

Hair must be a natural color

Shoes or boots are required at all times. Shoes or boots with blinking lights, noisemakers, wheels, heels or soles higher than

2 inches are prohibited at all times including free dress days. All shoes must be closed toe and closed heel

Free Dress Day - Absolutely no Tank tops, spaghetti straps, sleeveless shirts, crop tops, or belly shirts. Sheer or revealing shirts are not allowed. Any graphics or print must be appropriate and not distracting (as determined by school administrators). Shorts or other bottoms must be no shorter than 4" above the knee. Biker shorts are not to be used as outerwear. Shoe requirement are the same as any other day. i.e. closed heel, closed toe, no flip flops, sandals etc.
